- A Pap test (cervical smear test) does not detect ovarian cancer
- 2 Ovarian cancer is often diagnosed at a late stage
- Diagnosing ovarian cancer before it spreads makes it easier to treat and survive
  - Symptom awareness might lead to a more rapid diagnosis
  - Common symptoms include
    - a) Persistent bloating
      - b) Difficulty eating or feeling full quickly
      - c) Pelvic and abdominal pain
      - d) Urinary urgency or frequency
